## 'Inspiring Keynote Address'

Chief Guest, Ms. Rekha Mathews, all respected faculty members, proud parents and my dear friends. Four years ago when you came to Sahyadri, you and your parents placed your confidence in us, the management and the faculty members. Whatever vision and trust you had, I can confidently say that one hundred percent we have fulfilled your dream. The reason I am taking you back to four years ago is that when the first batch graduated, at that time it was the first batch that joined the college and they were the first graduating students who did not have the opportunities that you have today. In the last four years, eighty-four companies have visited the campus and they have extended opportunities for employment to all of you here today. I think that all will agree that being only an eight year old college, we have given you ample opportunity. When I interact with so many management people, they are surprised to know this. When you see so many different advertisements put out by colleges, very few of these colleges can confidently say that so many companies visited them for placement drives. Among these few colleges, I can say that Sahyadri is one among them. Dear students, today you have all passed out and are entering the new world. In the last four years, all of us, the faculty and the staff have tried to give their best

to you. When your parents first visited Sahyadri, they have handed over that responsibility to us and we have not failed you.

So far you have all been dependent people, but from today onwards, you are not dependent but are independent. Now, you can make your own decisions, what is right and what is wrong. It is all left to you. As usual, at the graduation ceremony we invite the chief guest who can be a role model for you because 90% of you will be entering the industry. Once you enter any industry you should have a role model you can look up to. Today, we have invited Mrs. Rekha Mathews as our chief guest who is a role model and she can share her experience with you and how she attained success in her life. This is very important for you. My advice to all of you who are not yet placed, don't be disheartened, you can now realize why you have not been placed but in a short span of time we have given you ample opportunity. Yet, there is still a lot of opportunity and scope available to you. How you utilize this opportunity is most important to you.

The word FAIL, F-A-I-L should not be taken literally but should be read as First Attempt In Learning. What VTU is giving you, that is academic knowledge and it is certified by the university. But that certificate needs



some value addition which is in your hands. That is what the industry needs - value addition. Technology is changing so quickly, academic universities or colleges give you this knowledge but outside there are a lot of opportunities for you; try to get the most out of this. For those who have been placed in various companies, you are now our Brand Ambassadors in the respective companies. The next batch of students have to get a job, they will look at your life and then come to our college. If you are good, your behaviour is good, if you are responsible people, if you are still working, then definitely they will know that Sahyadri is a good college, we will go and hire students from there. My sincere advice to all who are placed, don't think about the salary.

This is your first entry to a job in life and don't bother about the nature of work you are being given there. You are all young, don't bother about timings. All your efforts and hard work not only matters to you but it also matters to the institution as well. It matters to your juniors. Always keep this in mind and my request is that for another two years, don't try to switch over from one company to another. I understand that there are opportunities but we need stability. Be sincere and stay with that company for a minimum of at least two to three years. If you start jumping from one company to another, you not only cause injustice to the company but to your juniors as well. Think about all the efforts behind placing you in that company right from the placement, including the training department, the principal and each and every person and continue working with the company.

On the flight this morning from Bangalore, I read a paper in which two to three things were very nicely quoted. The first one is that, mistakes, failure and rejection are all part of growth and progress. If anyone has grown or progressed, then he or she has gone through all this. He may have made mistakes, he may have failed or have been rejected but eventually he has succeeded in life. Always try to keep this in mind. Until today you were not bothered about stress and tension but once you joined a company, the stress and tension begin. You were free minded people. There is a story very nicely written in a book. One group of students went to the college and discussed with their professor.

There were all placed in different companies. They began discussing about stress and tension they faced in their companies. The professor listened to all the discussion going on and he went to his kitchen and brought them coffees. There were different varieties of cups; some silver, some crystal, some paper cups and so on. The group of students picked up their coffee cups. The professor then told them to just notice how all of them had picked up all the expensive cups and not the ordinary paper cups. These paper cups were still left on the table. The professor then gently pointed out whether they wanted coffee or the cups. The coffee was the same in all the cups only the cups were different. This is the source of tension and stress. If you need only coffee there is no tension or stress, but if you go for the type of cups; crystal, silver, etc. this will create tension and stress. Life has a saying B to D where B is Birth and D is Death but what is the alphabet missing in between B & D? That is C and C is Choice. That is what your choice is – whether you are joining a job, salary, money, status is all left to you. So you have to make choices and in the same way choice between stress and tension.

The doors of Sahyadri are always open to you, whenever you feel like coming back, you are welcome to Sahyadri. Whatever good you learn in the outside world, please transfer that to your juniors. Our vision was to create a good institution for the society. When I first began this institution, the group of faculty members joined their hands and today we have created one of the best institutions in this area. Yesterday when I attended the VC's son's wedding in Bangalore, I met many management people and principals. The minute I was introduced, they say, "Oh, you are from Sahyadri." This is what we have created in the last eight years and as principal was telling me, now everybody knows about Sahyadri. This effort is not just from Manjunath Bhandary, but the hands of all the faculty members who joined together. Till now you were groomed to reach the next level, the country level or the international level. I am requesting you all for your support, support us, the faculty members, support the students and definitely one day Sahyadri will be recognized all over the world. Thank you.

This is the first time I am wearing this robe and head gear and all that. I feel very proud and I can imagine how proud each one of you would be feeling today. Is it? Are you feeling like it's a burden to carry this? Sixteen years of hard work. Sixteen years of hard work has come to this day, has come fruitful and it is a culminating on this day of celebration. You are indeed very fortunate to have a college that celebrates your success. It doesn't happen everywhere. So you should be feeling fortunate and again you should be fortunate to have a college which tells you that its doors are always open to you. I heard the chairman saying this in his address today. So feel fortunate and feel blessed to be here on this day to celebrate your success.

It is an important day for the college because its students are celebrating success. It is a more important day, a fulfilling day and gratifying day for your parents who have been the reasons behind your success. And again there are a few more people behind, they are sitting behind and they were there behind your success. Who are they? They are your teachers. Not

only teachers, there are a lot of other people who worked behind your success, the reasons for why you are here today; your placement team, your training team, the heads of the department, principal, a lot of people and well-wishers who have mentored you to reach this day. Be thankful to all of them. While celebrating success, it is very important to be thankful. I just remembered a story, which at this point in time I think it is relevant here. One young man went for an interview. He performed very well, he was technically very good. The interviewer was very happy with his performance and he was about to offer him a job, then he asked, who are your parents and what do they do. So this young man said, I don't have a father he passed away when I was young. So then, who takes care of you, who finances your studies? Do you work? No I don't work; I have my mother she is working. What does she do? He said, she is a dhobi, she washes clothes. So the interviewer was surprised. How can she work so hard to finance his engineering studies? Do you support her? She does not allow me to help in any way. She does all the work by herself and she tells me to go and

study, you become successful. I will do all the hard work for you. For a moment the interviewer was silent. He asked the young man to show his hands. His hands, his palms were very soft, very neat. So he understood that this young man had never in his life washed clothes. His mother was spending all her life washing clothes to support him. So the interviewer said, you go back home today and you look at your mothers hands and you come back. So that evening, the young man went back home and he was taking a look at his mothers hands. He saw her hands which were not soft, very hard, wrinkled out of the hard work for several years. He realized that he had never looked back; he had never seen his mother's hands even once. Tears flowed from his eyes and he sat there and kissed her hands and that day he washed all the clothes himself. He did not allow his mother to wash the clothes. He then came back and met the interviewer and the interviewer asked him, so that did you find out yesterday? So the young man said, I saw my mother's hands for the first time yesterday. I realized what it means to me. Today, I am a different person. This is what I want to tell you today. You may have not realized the people behind your success. They have been there, invisible many times. Realise that today and say a word of thanks. Will you. Yes. So that will be the foundation of your success. Be grateful for all that you have received. It is not because of our achievement, it is not just our achievement or our skills or our efficiency. We are here because there were a lot of people behind us. And when you go forward, many of you, I understand that about 80% of you are already placed. That's a big number. Let me congratulate the placement team and the entire college, I think they deserve a big applause. I learnt that 84 companies came to the campus. Congratulations to Rashmi, the Placement Officer. You have a very energetic person, I know her from two years ago. In government colleges and private colleges we find students with very high ranks and all that but the support they get from the college is very minimal. Even my daughter is entering the semester eight now she is studying in a government college. The involvement of the staff there is very limited so even the placement cell is made up of students, the students go to the companies, the students bring companies, the staff is not at all involved and they receive very minimum

training also. The seniors do the training. They don't have a training team. So unlike the government colleges, you have received all the support so you should be thankful and you should be making use of these facilities here and 80% of you are placed just like the chairman was saying, you haven't got a placement till now, this is not the entire thing. Recently I went to a company in Chennai where my daughter is doing an internship. I found many freshers waiting for an interview. I was just talking to them and they told me that they did not get campus placement and they were doing a course in embedded systems in Chennai or some place and this company goes there. Many good companies like Bosch or Tata Elxsi they all go there to this interview and recruit students. So the people who



are not yet placed there is no reason for you to get disheartened, but it is very important for you to learn from your mistakes so far, to learn from your drawbacks. By this time you would have attended many placement drives, you would have realized where you are lacking. If you are not able to clear the online aptitude test, that means you need to improve your skills. You spend some time to improve your skills. You spend some time even for bank coaching. If you are not able to be successful on your own, attend the coaching and then get some training and perfect your skills; it is all practice. The aptitude tests is all practice and if you haven't spent enough time during these four years to perfect your subject knowledge, spend some time to perfect that knowledge and spend some time even for the students who are already placed to improve your skills. Before you get your joining dates, spend some time doing a course.

We recruit students from engineering colleges for software coding, testing and other kinds of jobs, but sometimes we will be calling them for a Java batch or for a mainframe batch depending on the requirements prevailing at that time. But still if you are thorough in any one programming language, it will help you to excel when you come for the training. This is specifically true in the case of non-IT branches. For non-IT branches, when you come for an IT job, I think 80% of placement is hired from IT right, so one thing we find is that the non-IT people do not have that acceptance so the acceptance makes a lot of difference. When we accept something, anything when you have that acceptance, you will be able to perform better. Coming to success, the three I's for success are Insight, Inspiration and the third one is Integrity. Insight is when you do something, you should know the purpose. Why am I doing this?

succeed. Just like chairman was telling you today, the first salary is not at all important for learning. If you don't learn after you work for five years in a company will it add to your experience? What is called experience? You will not gain experience just because you are working somewhere. You will gain experience only if you are there in it with your full heart and full passion. Only then will you learn things. Only then will you succeed and grow further. And all the time, continuous learning is key.

When I passed my tenth standard with good marks, I felt very successful. When I went to the pre-university class I realized that unless I get through the entrance examination with a good score I will not get a good admission in a good college. So until then I felt very successful for maybe a few days, a few weeks or a few months. And everybody celebrates your success also but after you fail in the second step will anybody remember your success? No one will remember your success. You have to repeat your success. Then only you remain successful. You have to repeat success. At every step you will realise that there are many more steps to go. There are many more things to achieve. There are many more obstacles to tackle. Life is not about obstacles. Today this is your key to independence. You become financially independent. You are graduating from a student life to a career. You may think that life ahead will be very smooth. Till now I had to study a lot. It was all hard work but going ahead, I will get the salary, go for movies, picnic and live very happily. It is not like that. We have to be on the learning continuously otherwise what will happen; you will get outdated.

Have a goal or a purpose. Do everything with a purpose. Second is Inspiration. That is passion. People who are interested in dance, music, they have that passion. May be some other people have other passions. But when you are in your work you should have a similar passion. We call it passionate entrepreneurship. What is the difference in entrepreneurship? What is entrepreneurship? If you are starting your own company or enterprise, we call them an entrepreneur. But when you are working for others will it be different usually. If it is your own company will you look at the watch. When you work because you have put your money in it, you have put your hard work in it, you will not look at the watch in the same way for someone else also put your passion and your passionate entrepreneurship then you will

Today's world is a technological world. Technology has changed our entire life. Do you have any idea of the life span of a technology? It is just 33 days. By the time you learn something, you get a newer version. Many of you have smart phones, in fact most of you and you get software updates right? Every two weeks or three weeks the software is updated with new versions. That is the case of technology. By the time you learn something, the next version will come. So keep on learning continuously otherwise you will be like a typewriter. How many of you know about the typewriter. The people sitting on the dais they know.

When the word processors came, it came with a lot of additional features and we could save the matter for future use. We could take multiple copies without compromising on the clarity. Similar things happened in all other areas; we don't see the old video cassettes now, even the floppy disks or CD's everything is getting compact into a small memory stick. 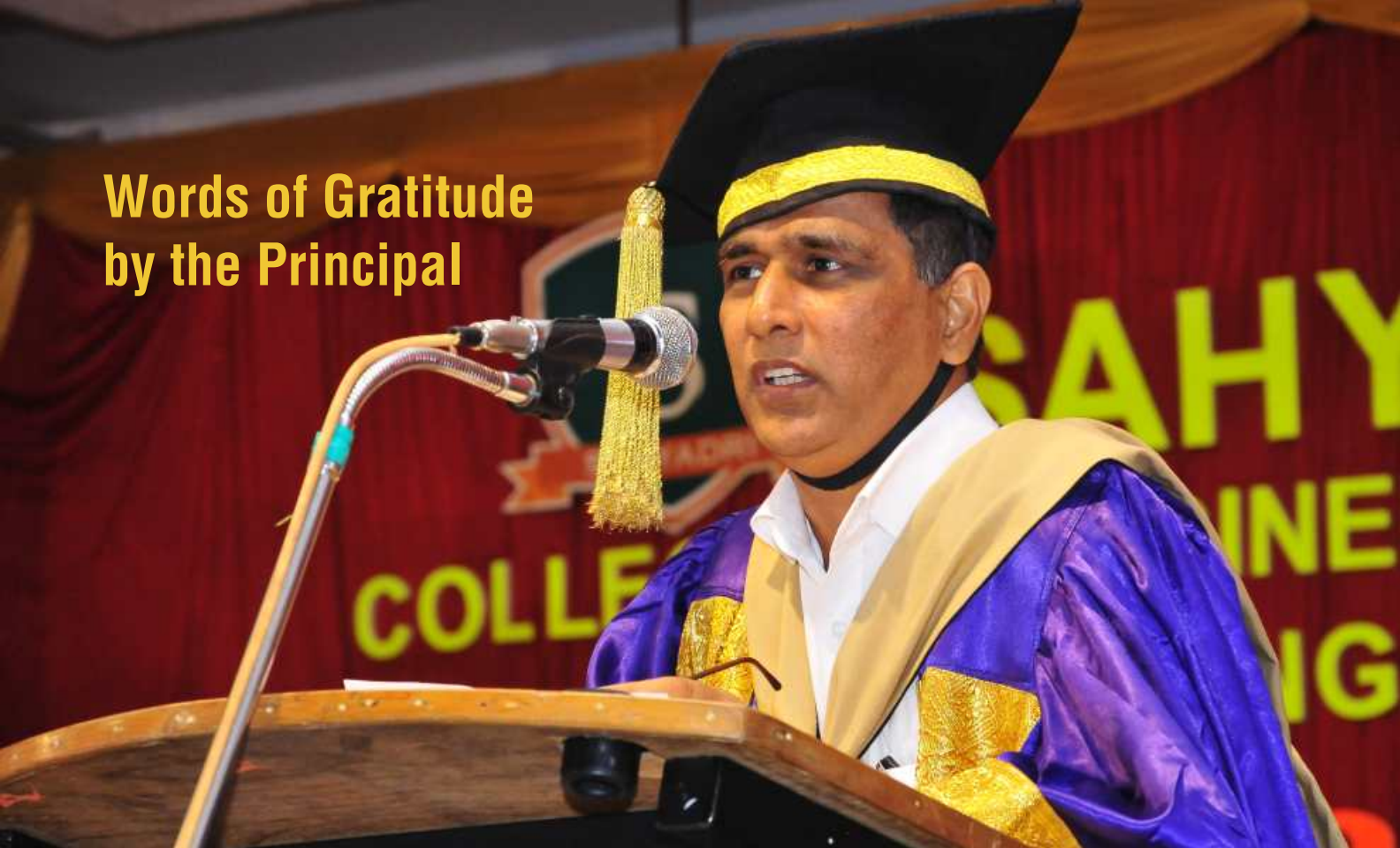
