Sahyadri College of Engineering & Management, Mangalore has been taking initiation to groom the students not just in the engineering or masters courses but also in the overall development of the student community.

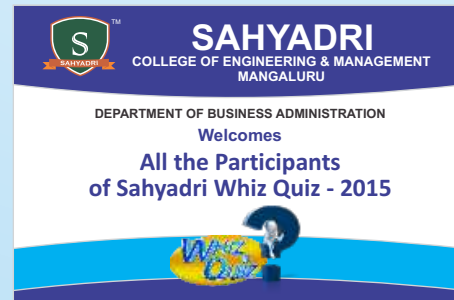
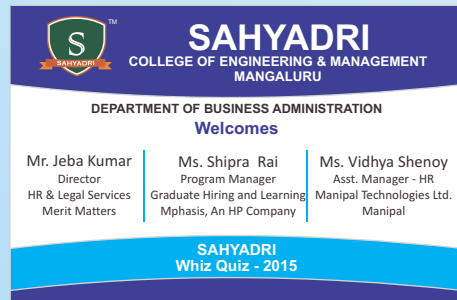

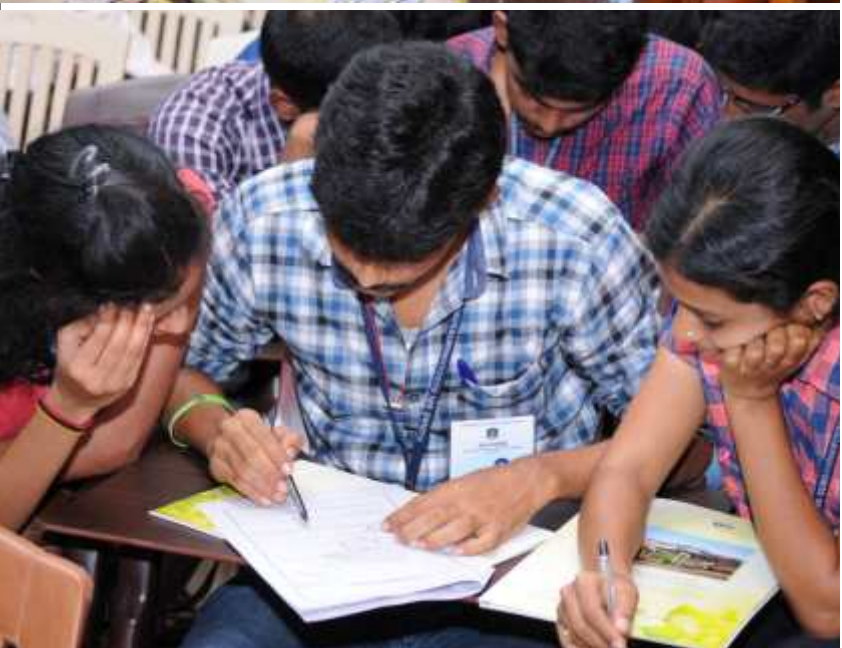
