

Engg colleges in state struggling to survive?

ENGINEERING colleges in the state are struggling to survive, according to management representatives of such colleges.

At a summit organised by Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belagavi, with presidents, chairmen and members of managements of engineering colleges affiliated to it, in the city on Monday, representatives of several colleges expressed that they were under financial burden.

They requested the university authorities to at least relax the procedural measures to close down colleges.

MP Suresh C Angadi, who is chairman of Angadi Institute of Technology, Belagavi, said, "To get permission to open a college, one has to undergo hundreds of procedures. Shutting down colleges has more procedures than setting one up. My request on behalf of all college managements is to relax those measures."

According to the managements, if the procedure to close down colleges is relaxed, then it would be easy for them to set up



or run another business in that infrastructure. "If the closing down procedures are easier, at least we can run a hotel and recover the revenue invested to build the college," said Angadi.

A representative of RL Jalappa Institute of Technology said, "The All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has said that if the 30 per cent of seats in engineering colleges are vacant, then they can be closed down. But I feel that it should be 50 per cent because it will help many colleges. Most colleges are struggling to run and there are vacant seats. It would be helpful for colleges if the closure procedure is easier."
