

SCEM inks pact with AIESEC India

MANGALURU, DHNS: With the prime objective of encouraging International Internships for students, Sahyadri College of Engineering and Management (SCEM), Mangaluru, has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with AIESEC India, providing a global platform for youth to explore and develop leadership potential.
