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# Action taken based on the previous meeting held in the month of February, 2018:

- **7.** Around 6000 students from various colleges were reached out for Whiz-Quiz so that more UG students learn through the process
- **8.** Bridge course of around two weeks was organized for first year engineering students to expose them to practical aspects of engineering
- **9.** Student Mentoring process was put in place and hence faculties motivated students to takeup better internships
- **10.** HOD's submitted the budget requirements with actual expenses of previous years to get the approval by the Governing Council
- **11.** TechVision 2018, a one day intercollegiate annual project competition was conducted on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2018.
- **12.** Technical and General aptitude training sessions was conducted for engineering students through a outsourced agency to enhance technical and aptitude skills.

### Discussion Points for the month of February 2018:

- It was observed that the students needed to be motivated right from their family and not just through the faculty. Hence an Orientation program for parents was planned
- 2. It was decided to reach out more colleges for Sahyadri Science Talent Hunt to be conducted, further enable the projects to get funded. It was decided to drive the program through first year engineering students.
- **3.** The members planned to send more students to NIT, IIT and elite institutions for competitions so that students are exposed to the working culture of those institutions.
- **4.** Communication being a common issue with the students, which was also a feedback from the recruiters, it was decided to install Toastmaster club at campus.

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- **5.** To offer more connectivity in relation to industry requirements, it was decided to sign a MOU with Nasscom, a premier institution.
- **6.** Although startup culture was created it was also the need of the hour to make the startups aware about Intellectual Property Rights. Hence it was planned to conduct a workshop on the same.
